The sessions were conducted to enhance participants' technical proficiency and strengthen their understanding of advanced bridge modeling and design methodologies in accordance with industry practices. Upon successful completion of the training program, all participating employees were awarded official certificates of participation by the MIDAS organization, recognizing their attendance and successful completion of the course. This initiative reflects the company's ongoing commitment to developing a highly skilled, technically competent, and professionally capable workforce.

ISO 9001:2015 SURVEILLANCE 2 AUDIT
